Autumn Term (The funding has provided the opportunity of the following :

- All of Year 2 have had the opportunity to work with a Gym Specialist for a term
- All of Year 1 and 2 children have had the opportunity to learn to ride a scooter safely

- 10 children, from Year 2, were selected to take part in an Invasion games festival
- 8 children, from Year 2, were selected to take part in an Athletics competition
- All of Year 2 children had a taster session in 'Outdoor Learning'

Spring Term (The funding has provided the opportunity of the following :

- Inset was provided for staff, this was 'Numeracy in Action'
- All pupils had the opportunity to experience 'Numeracy in Action' intra delivered by Active Luton
- 8 Year 2 children had the opportunity to attend a 'Net' Wall festival
- 2 Year 2 children have been trained as Bonze Ambassadors
- Midday supervisor have had CPD, provided by 'Active Luton'
- All of Year 2 are being given the opportunity to work with a Dance specialist for a term
- All of Year 1 are being given the opportunity to work with a Gymnastics specialist for a term

Summer Term

- Before school and at lunch times P.E clubs are being offered to the children, free of charge. These are the following; Dance, Active Adventure and Handball.
- 'A Life' visited and worked with the whole school. They provided a range of activities for the children to engage in to promote healthy eating and a healthy life style.
- Active Luton provided CPD for our new play leader.

Funding for Transport

Part of the Sports Premium funding has been used to provide transport for pupils to attend competitions/festivals. These included a Net Wall festival, an athletics festival and a football competition.

Feedback and monitoring

This will be achieved by evaluations completed by staff members involved , pupil questionnaires and interviews with the school council.. Both the feedback and the questionnaires will form the basis of showing the impact that the activities have had at raising the quality of physical activity at Foxdell Infants School.

The difference it has made/will make:

Numeracy in Action is developing throughout the school. The pupils appear more engaged and are enthusiastic and keen to take part in learning.

The pupils have been very excited when the 'Sporting Specialists' have been in to teach and this has had an impact on pupil participation. Most of our pupils become very animated during the sessions and produce quality work. Staffs have also benefited working with the 'Specialists' and are becoming more confident with the delivery of Dance and Gym.

More clubs are going to be offered to children, during the school day, as a way of providing sporting opportunities for pupil to access.

The 'Play Buddies' have been a real success; the children are keen to lead games and have been promoting good Citizenship. The structured games have had an impact on promoting positive behaviour.

The lunch time P.E club has been very successful. We have had a huge uptake (especially the Active Adventure) The before and after school have not been as successful, to address this we have invited one of our sports provider into school so that he can 'show case' all of the clubs they could provide.

We intend to ask the children, using our school council, which clubs that they would like in September.
