Key texts: The Journey Home

During this half term the children will be looking at two texts - Wolves and The Journey Home. The learning will include writing a fact sheet about wolves

and using the text maps to orally retell the story. The children will also have opportunities to display their creative writing whilst writing their own stories.

History

English



This unit we will explore the development of travel and transport throughout history. We will look at chronology through using timelines and making comparisons between old and new forms of transport.

We will be exploring the formal elements of art: pattern, texture, tone. Children will create printed patterns using everyday objects, take rubbings using different media and learn how to make their drawings three dimensional.

The children will be learning about how and why different religions celebrate significant times. They will also begin to understand what makes some celebrations sacred to believers.

Reminders

Maths

PE



During PE this half term, the children will be learning key elements of coordination and practising their balance and travelling skills. They will learn how to incorporate these into a sequence of movements.

The children will explore their hopes and fears and begin to understand rewards and consequences of their actions.

The children will revisit how to stay sate on the internet. They will also be looking at recognising common uses of technology beyond school.
