English



Key texts: Stone Age Boy & The Stolen Spear This half term, we will be looking at the focus text 'Stone Age Boy' and using this as a stimulus to write a recount in the role of the main character. We will also explore 'Defeating The Monster' stories and write our own versions.

History

We will be learning about life in the Stone Age and describe the changes that happened in Britain resulting from metal discovery. We will also compare and contrast historical eras (Stone & Bronze Age).

Art/DT

We will be learning to use charcoal to recreate the style of cave artists and demonstrate a good understanding of colour mixing with natural pigments.

RE

We will be looking at places of worship for different religions. We will also compare and contrast how worship is conducted in different religions.
