

English -Key texts: The Time Travelling Cat and The Egyptian Goddess

We will write an information text on Ancient Egypt and a story based on our class novel. Children will continue to practise the use of conjunctions as well as a range of punctuation correctly including capital letters, full stops and question marks.

Our class novel for this half term is 'The Time Travelling Cat and the Egyptian Goddess.'

History-Ancient Egypt

This half term, we will learn when Ancient Egyptians lived, investigate early settlements and their location and make links with cities today.

We will also learn the importance of the River Nile to the Ancient Egyptians.



Art/DT

This half term, we will explore Ancient Egyptian art and learn about how and why it was created. We will also design and create Ancient Egyptian-inspired scrolls.

RE

We will identify texts that come from a Gospel, which tells the story of the life and teaching of Jesus. We will also explore how Christian leaders try to follow Jesus' teaching in different ways.

Science- Plants
