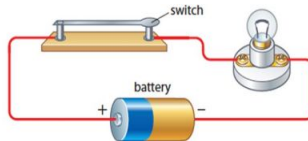

Music

This half term the children will focus on electricity. We will learn about insulators and conductors.

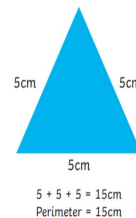


French

In French, the children will learn how to talk about our interests and hobbies.

Maths

Our maths this half term focuses on multiplication and division as well as length and perimeter. We will continue with the Mastering Numbers Programme which enables children to develop fluency in multiplication and division facts. Remember to do some Times Tables Rock Stars - we recommend at least three times each week, but every day is even better!



PE The children will be learning about balance and how to use different parts of their bodies to balance. We will also be focusing on dance. PE lessons will take place as follows: **Ash**— Tuesday and Thursday; **Beech** — Tuesday and Friday (swimming); **Oak** — Wednesday and Friday.

PSHE

The children will explore their dreams and goals. We will learn about creating and achieving goals as well as overcoming obstacles of disappointment.
