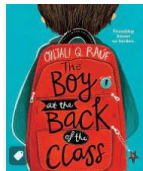

## Year 5 Curriculum Maps Spring 1

### Values Relationships

Friendship Trust Empathy  
**Reminders: Reading daily for at least 20 minutes and  
reading record to be signed daily. Homework MUST be  
completed weekly and spellings learned**

**Music**– Pupils will continue to using their knowledge of  
pitch and tone to learn how to play the violin. They will  
also be learning to read music to enable them to  
perform a song.

### Computing

Pupils will be learning to develop their understanding of  
computer systems and how information is transferred  
between systems and devices

### Science – Forces and Gravity

Pupils will learn about the forces of gravity, air  
resistance, water resistance and friction. They will learn  
how and why levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller  
force to have a greater effect.

## Maths: White Rose Maths

Pupils will focus on multiplying and dividing  
increasingly large numbers using a formal method.  
They will utilise and extend this knowledge through  
problem solving and reasoning questions. Pupils will  
learn to multiply fractions by an integer and find  
fractions of an amount

## PE

In dance they will develop shapes and circles and  
create series of movements with these through  
partnering and artistry.

## PSHE

Pupils will be exploring a range of jobs carried out by
