Values – Happiness, Love and Cooperation

Key dates – Healthy Living Week, Whipsnade Trip

Reminders: Reading daily for at least 20 minutes and reading record to be signed daily. Homework must also be completed weekly and spellings learned.

Music

We are using our knowledge of pitch and tone to learn how to play the violin.

RE: We are learning about Christianity and how Christians perceive God as a holy Being.

Science – We are learning about what a fair test is and how different variables can effect our test results.

Maths: White Rose Maths – We are focussing on decimals, percentages, perimeter and area, as well statistics. Children will build on learning from earlier years to find the perimeters of rectangles by measuring the sides and by calculation. We will also be learning about types of graphs for example conversation graphs. Children will also be encouraged to join points using a straight dashed line and discuss the fact that this is used because they cannot be certain of the exact values between two given points.

PE – We are developing our PE skills focussing on sequencing and dynamic balance.
