English: Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo During this half term, children will be reading Michael Morpurgo's version of the classic tale of Beowulf. We will be writing out own suspenseful and description filled stories all about defeating a monster.

History: The Anglo Saxons

Linking the traditional tale above, children will be learning about what life was like in Britain for the Anglo Saxons. Children will look at daily life and compare their days to ours. We will also look at broader historical themes such as invading and settling under a single monarch.



Art: Retrofuturism

Retrofuturism is looking at futuristic images created in the past. Children will be investigating and then creating their own art in this theme.

French - Food Pupils will learn the vocabulary associated with food; express opinions about food and talk about healthy and unhealthy food.
