

### English: Holes by Louis Sachar

We will be starting our writing this term by reading, writing and performing rap poems on the topic of healthy living. We will then be using our class novel as stimulus for writing an advisory report about the camp that features in the book. In reading lessons, children will be exposed to a range of texts in preparation for next term's SATs tests.

### Humanities: Comparing Locations

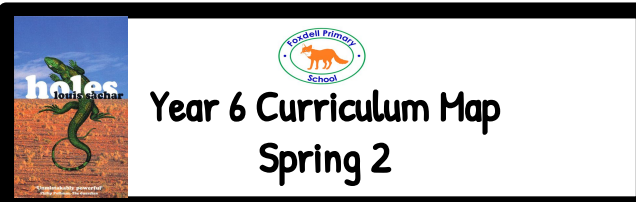
Following on from our work about World War II, the children will be comparing what life is like today in towns in countries that were involved in the war. We will be focusing on towns the size of Luton in Japan and America. We will look at both the human and physical geography of each location.

### Art/DT: Playground Structures

The children will research existing playground equipment and their different forms, before designing and developing a range of apparatus to meet a list of specified design criteria.

### RE: What do Christians believe Jesus did to help people?

The children will consider the idea of being saved from sin, which is such a significant element of the Christian faith. They will compare this to the beliefs of other religions.



## Year 6 Curriculum Map Spring 2

### Values Positivity

**Reminders:** maths, spelling and English homework will be set each week. We will also be setting a geography based project which each child should be prepared to present at the end of the term.

### Music

The children will learn a range of percussion skills as well as being introduced to samba music.

### Science: Electricity

The children will be set the task of building an electrical device and then learning the necessary knowledge and skills to complete the task effectively. This will include understanding how circuits work as well as how to improve their efficiency and how to remain safe. .

### French

The children will practise talking and writing about time and forms of transport in France.

### Maths

This term, the children will be working on algebra, percentages, measurement and statistics. We will then be applying these skills to word problems. We will continue to practise the four operations and fractions in preparation for the SATs tests. We will also be practising a range of reasoning questions based on all the topics the children have studied this year.

### PE

The children will develop & apply their balancing skills to a range of sporting situations. They will also be learning basic acrobatic skills in gymnastics. PE sessions will be as follows: . Kites—Tuesday and Thursday; Kestrels— Tuesday and Thursday; Eagles— Thursday and Friday .

### PSHE

Our unit for this term is Celebrating Differences and will provide the children with an opportunity to consider how each of us is unique and that we should celebrate those differences.

### Computing: Building Websites

The children have now learnt the basics of web design and will continue to work on their own website about a topic of their choice. They will also consider how to keep safe online.
