

English: Crater Lake by Jennifer Killick

This term we will be completing a variety of short writing tasks to support the children in revising for the upcoming SATs tests. These will be linked to our class novel and work we are doing in other areas of the curriculum. In reading lessons, children will be practising key skills needed for the upcoming tests.

Humanities: Democracy

The children will have an opportunity to learn what we mean by democracy as well as looking at our democratic system including the Houses of Parliament and local government. We will look at how the right to vote has changed over time

Art/DT: Playground Structures

The children will research existing playground equipment and their different forms, before designing and developing a range of apparatus to meet a list of specified design criteria.

RE: How is faith expressed in Islam?

The children will consider the idea of faith from a number of perspectives and religious viewpoints as well as a more in depth study of what faith looks like in Islam. .

Values Diversity

Reminders: SATs week will take place from Monday 13th May to Thursday 18th May. It is imperative that all children are in school by 8.45 each of these days to ensure we can complete the tests.

Music

The children will be learning to play African inspired music and how to play traditional African djembe drums.

Science: Life Cycles

The children will have an opportunity to revisit their learning about life cycles of animals and plants. They will also be revising a range of topics studied in science during key stage 2.

French

The children will learn how to talk about sports and hobbies in French as well as learn which sports are popular in France.

Maths

This term, the children will be working on geometry, including 2D and 3D shapes, calculating and measuring angles, position and direction as well as volume. We will also be reviewing key concepts in preparation for the SATs tests and practising answering SATs style questions.

PE

The children will work on their sending and receiving skills by undertaking a range of activities. They will also be working on improving their cricket and rounders skills. PE sessions will be as follows: Kites—Tuesday and Thursday; Kestrels— Tuesday and Thursday; Eagles— Thursday and Friday .

PSHE

Our unit for this term is about the different relationships we have in our lives. We will look at ways to ensure we maintain good mental health both in and through our healthy relationships.

Computing: Spreadsheets

The children will identify, collect and analyse different types of data which they will then manipulate and re-present using graphs and reports using spreadsheets to collect and sort that information.
