Key texts: *Kassim and the Greedy Dragon*

This term, we will be reading a fiction book about Kassim and the Dragon. Children will learn how to write a descriptive story and will be using a variety of adjectives and noun phrases. They will also be learning how to use different sentence starters to enhance their description.

History



In History this term, children will learn about the role of monarchs and their responsibilities. They will explore what happens during a coronation ceremony and why it is important. Pupils will also study William the Conqueror, including how he became king and the significance of the Battle of Hastings.

DT



The children will describe fruits and vegetables and explain how to identify fruits. They will also name a range of places that fruits and vegetables grow as well as describe basic characteristics of fruit and vegetables.

RE



We will be exploring the concept 'morals and manners' across different faiths. We will learn through stories and discuss similarities and differences between them.

Music



In music, we will continue to learn about rhythm, tempo and dynamics. We will learn to read notes and use simple instruments to play the tune.

Science



This half term, we will explore the basic needs necessary for survival (water, food and air) for animals and humans. We will end the term looking at the importance of staying healthy and explore different activities that can help us stay healthy during Healthy Living Week.

Maths



Children will be learning about shapes including fractions. Children will learn how to recognise a half, third and quarter of a shape and learn about fractions of numbers. We will also learn how to read the time including o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. Children will be using both analogue and digital clocks.

PE



The children will be learning how to develop and apply their sending and receiving skills. They will practise their reaction responses through focused skill sessions, cooperative and competitive games. They will also practise different skills in preparation for Sports Day.

PSHE



Our topic is called 'Relationships', where we look at how we feel being a part of a family and what relationships we form within it. We will discuss conflict with friends as part of the topic, with a focus on how to solve them.

Computing

Children will use yes and no questions to separate different items. We will learn what a database is and how to use it to answer questions. We will also create pictograms and discuss online safety.
