

## English

Our class novel for this half term is 'A Mummy Ate My Homework'. Using our history topic as inspiration, we will write an information text on Ancient Egypt. We will be focusing on the accurate use of subheadings and how to open sentences using subordinate clauses.



## History-Ancient Egypt

This half term, we will learn when Ancient Egyptians lived, investigate early settlements and their location and make links with cities today. We will also learn the importance of the River Nile to the Ancient Egyptians.



## Art/DT

This half term, we will explore Ancient Egyptian art and learn about how and why it was created. We will also design and create Ancient Egyptian-inspired scrolls.

## RE

We will be exploring 'Why is water symbolic?' The children will be making connection between religious stories and importance of water. We will be answering a question on 'How water is used in some rituals?'

## Science- Forces
